what a gift to United Way provides

50¢ per week provides...

- one preschool child with one book per month for a year to promote early childhood literacy.
- 6 hot meals delivered to an elderly or disabled homebound person.

\$1 per week provides...

- one-person emotional support after the loss of a loved one.
- a parent dependent on DCF to get back to workforce and have them child in daycare.

\$2 per week provides...

- mental health education, awareness, and prevention for a child at risk of abuse.
- a full year's membership to Boys and Girls Club.

\$5 per week provides...

- a low-income individual with support for food, clothing, utilities and roof overhead.
- temporary shelter and counseling for women and children escaping domestic violence.
